

# **CHOICE OF THE TRACK**

### Standard track

Bachelor's degree of 180 ECTS is required | Duration 2 years | 4 semesters

# Fast track

Bachelor's degree of 210 ECTS is required | Duration 1.5 years | 3 semesters

### Part-time track

Bachelor's degree of 210 ECTS is required | Duration 2.5 years | 5 semesters | Internship can be validated by equivalent relevant work experience.

### Cooperation track

Bachelor's of 180 ECTS is required | Duration 2 years | 4 semesters | 2 semesters abroad (please enquire).

Our MSc International Management program provides you with the management skills and operations mindset to become a change maker and an effective leader in any industry on an international level. The courses cover a broad range of topics in the key business administration fields, such as finance, marketing, logistics, human resources, and sustainability, providing you with a 360° view of the business scheme and the tools to move a company forward in an international setting. The studies are also customized with elective modules.

In a world on the verge of a new era, dominated by the power of AI and big data, the global economy requires leaders who can foresee rapid changes in operations and efficiently adapt the resources and supply chains of their companies to the newest developments of technology, and unpredictable demand. # FINANCING YOUR STUDIES

# **YOUR OPTIONS**



### **BRAIN CAPITAL**

KLU offers the innovative financing plan, Brain Capital, which could cover up to 50–100% of the tuition fees. You can pursue your degree without having to pay tuition that exceeds your financial resources. In return, you will commit to an incomedependent repayment plan after graduation.





# **SCHOLARSHIPS**

KLU offers merit-based scholarships for students with very high academic achievement. These scholarships cover up to 100% of tuition. Applicants are chosen based on their outstanding academic performance and their social and international engagement. Also, the DAAD's scholarship database offers you a wide range of tips and information on successfully applying for a scholarship in Germany.



### **AWARDS**

If you are a scholarship holder of one of the institutions for gifted education in Germany (Begabtenförderwerke), supported by the Federal Ministry of Education and Research, you may apply for an award, consisting of a full tuition fee waiver at KLU.



### PART-TIME WORK

Students from outside of the EU are allowed to work 120 full days or 240 half days per year. We recommend that students from EU countries that wish to work do not exceed 20 hours.



# **TAX SAVINGS**

In Germany, tuition can be claimed on tax returns after graduation. All master's degree students can claim all the costs of their degree program as a loss carry-forward in the income-tax declaration after their studies are completed. This reduces the taxable income of the graduate in the years after their studies, thus saving money in taxes.



### PERSONAL FINANCIAL RESOURCES

To provide for all personal expenses throughout the study program in Hamburg, students shall count on some amount of savings or personal financial resources. For those planning on relying on a loan from their origin country, we recommend starting the process quite far in advance to avoid delays in the enrollment.

- Early-bird discount 10%, deadline: January 15
- International application deadline: May 31
- German & EU Application deadline: July 15
- Start of program: September 1

# **APPLICATION PROCESS**



- Please note: you do not need all your final documents to submit your application.
- Application fee: A non-refundable application fee of €50 is required from Non-EU/EEA applicants upfront. If you are a non-EU citizen holding a German Bachelor's degree you do not have to pay the application fee.
- Tuition fees are charged per semester. A non-refundable deposit of € 1,000 will be due two weeks after the receipt of the study contract. The deposit will be deducted from the first tuition fee installment.
